

# Weedbusters 2-min Film Challenge

## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- Weedbusters 2-minute Film Challenge is open to all New Zealand schools.
- The students taking part must be in years 1–8 or being taught at that level.
- The entering team may be a class of students or a group of students within a class or another type of group within a single school.
- More than one class of students or group of students within a school from one school may enter.
- The students taking part must be entered by a New Zealand school and the teacher or principal in charge must make that entry.
- The movie/slideshow/animation must be original and unpublished. Entries must not include copied material or copyrighted materials that belong to third parties.
- If required the school must be able to produce written permissions for all actors within the movie agreeing to be screened on YouTube and promoted through the Weedbusters NZ website.
- Teachers must clearly state in the entry form that they have supported the production of the movie/slideshow/animation and that the students have created all parts of the movie/slideshow/animation.
- Each entry must be one complete story.
- Entries must comply with the requirements set out in the Entry Criteria section.
- All entries must be submitted within the official online entry form.
- The copyright in all entries will remain with the creators of the movie/slideshow/animation. Authorship should take the following form: 'Written and developed by the children of Room x, Xxxxx School'.
- By submitting an entry to the competition, the school and the authors and creators of the movie/slideshow/animation give Weedbusters New Zealand right to take copies to publish the movie/slideshow/animation (or part of it), without charge in all media.
- Entries close at 5pm, 1 October each year.
- Judging will be carried out before 30 November each year and winners notified by 5 December.
