


Plants from your aquarium or garden pond can become nasty waterweeds in lakes, rivers or streams.



They spread rapidly, making it hard for other water plants and fish to survive. They choke lakes and rivers, make swimming unpleasant, fishing difficult and boating hazardous.

- Source your aquatic plants from reputable garden and aquarium shops.
- Empty your aquarium well away from any natural areas.
- Compost any waste when you clear out your garden pond.
