Chop down choking vines

Flowering climbers look great over pergolas or fences, but make sure what you grow won't end up being an unruly nightmare for you and your neighbours, and a threat to natural areas nearby.

Most of the weedy climbers choking our bush were originally garden species that have 'gone wild'. They spread by seed or by the dumping of garden waste.

Be selective in planting climbers in your garden and remove any that are causing problems. Dispose of weed waste wisely.
