


On farms and lifestyle blocks, fencing and planting natives along waterways helps prevent stream bank erosion and improve water quality.

The downside is that, without good planning and maintenance, these areas can become a weedy mess where native plants struggle to survive.



Make weeds unwelcome along your waterways.

- Remove aggressive weeds before you fence and plant.
- Plant fast growing natives, and don't leave big gaps for weeds.
- Keep weeds at bay until the native plants are wellestablished.
